


WHISTLE SIGNALS

Sequence	What it means
Series of short sounds	Used when an emergency exists,
	or if persons or livestock are on the track.
_	When train is stopped.
	The air brakes are applied and pressure is equalized.
	Train releases brakes and proceeds.
0 0	Acknowledgment of any signal
	not otherwise provided for.
000	When train is stopped: means backing up,
	or acknowledgment of a hand signal to back up.
0000	Request for a signal to be given or
	repeated if not understood.
000	Instruction for flagman to protect rear of train.
	Flagman return from the west or south.
	Flagman return from the east or north.
o -	Train is approaching public grade crossing(s).
- o	Inspect the brake system for leaks or sticking brakes.
